Manhole & Catch Basin Installation

Intersection of 48th Avenue & 69th Street

On/About September 19th, 2016 to September 23rd, 2016
Mondays – Fridays 7:00am – 6:00pm

On/about September 19, 2016 and continuing for approximately one (1) week, temporary elimination of curbside parking and restrictions to driveway access will be in effect at the intersections of 48th Avenue & 69th Street. Traffic going West to East on 48th Avenue from 69th Street will be blocked for the duration of the operation. Please follow detour signs. These impacts are associated with the manhole and catch basin installation being performed by the NYC Department of Design and Construction (NYCDDC) for the Replacement of Combined Sewers in Calamus Avenue & 69th Street.

Community Impacts:

- Temporary elimination of curbside parking and restrictions to driveway access along the intersection of 48th Avenue & 69th Street. (East side only)
- The contractor will keep maintaining one (1) eleven (11) foot lane for southbound traffic.
- The NYCDDC will monitor operations and work within the DEP Noise Code regulations.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained at all times.
- Parking will be reinstated when contractor is not actively working on this block.
- Signs will be posted in the affected areas.
