




Important Notice

Queens Boulevard under Woodhaven Boulevard

Queens Community Board No. 4 August 2016

The NYC Department of Transportation Division of Bridges will make urgent repairs to the Woodhaven Boulevard Bridge over Queens Boulevard during the weekend of August 20-21, requiring the **full closure** of the Queens Boulevard main roadway between 57th Avenue and 62nd Drive starting on Friday, August 19, at 11:00 p.m. and continuing through Monday, August 22, at 5:00 a.m. Single-lane closures will be in effect eastbound starting at Grand Avenue and westbound starting at Junction Boulevard. The exit ramp from the westbound Long Island Expressway to Queens Boulevard will also be closed. In order to maintain two lanes of traffic on the Queens Boulevard service roads, parking will be restricted.




54-Hour Continuous Full Closure

Service roads will remain open but parking will be restricted.

Traffic Impacts

Queens Boulevard Main (Express) Roadway

- Eastbound
 - One lane closed starting at Grand Avenue
 - Full closure starting at 57th Avenue
- Westbound
 - One lane closed starting at Junction Boulevard
 - Full closure starting at 62nd Drive / 63rd Avenue

Queens Boulevard Service Roads

- Two lanes open to traffic in each direction
- Parking restricted

Westbound LIE, Exit 19

- Ramp to Queens Boulevard closed
- Ramp to Woodhaven Boulevard open

Woodhaven Boulevard

- Open to traffic
