PULASKI BRIDGE PEDESTRIAN AND BICYCLE IMPROVEMENTS

Brooklyn/Queens CB-BK1 / CB-Q2 April 2016

The New York City Department of Transportation will close the Pulaski Bridge to vehicular traffic on **Friday April 15, from 12:01am to 5:00am**. The closure affects vehicular, pedestrian and bicycle traffic, including the **B62 bus**. Detour signs will be posted. The closure is necessary as installation of the bicycle lane continues.



QUEENS BOUND B62 DETOUR

Manhattan Ave. - Right onto Greenpoint Ave., - Proceed over the Greenpoint Ave Bridge. - Left onto Review Ave., - Left turn onto Borden Ave., - Right turn onto Jackson Ave. - Resume usual route.

BROOKLYN BOUND B62 DETOUR

Bus will run on Borden Avenue past the Pulaski Bridge. - Straight on Borden Ave. - Right turn onto Van Dam St. - Greenpoint Bridge to Greenpoint Avenue. - Left turn onto Manhattan Ave., Resume the usual route.
