NYC DOT will conduct work along Vernon Boulevard. Improvements include:

- Install jersey barriers at key locations, strengthening the physical separation between path users and moving traffic
- Install flexible delineators to promote safer travel for all users
- Improve connections between on-street path and park paths to create a continuous greenway experience

Implementation starts in late-June


