Street Closure

Beginning March 31st, 2014, 44th Avenue between 97th Place and National Street will be temporarily closed from 7am to 6pm, Monday through Saturday until September 27, 2014 for erection of steel for the new school being built at 98-11 44th Avenue.

One-way Street Conversion

The 110th Precinct has requested that the Department of Transportation investigate the feasibility of changing the direction of traffic flow on 42nd Avenue between Junction Blvd. and 94th Street from two-way operation to one-way operation eastbound. This request emanates from the safety issues caused by the narrow width of 42nd Avenue. The Department of Transportation has concluded that this conversion would improve safety of pedestrians and motorists. In addition to a one-way conversion, the Department of Transportation also recommends the removal of 2 parking spots to improve visibility at the following intersections:

- Northeast corner of 42nd Avenue at Warren Street
- Northeast and Southeast corners of 42nd Avenue at 95th Street
- Northeast and Southeast corners of 94th Street at 42nd Avenue
