 It seems that no matter what we do, the moment our streets are cleared of snow, another storm comes along, and has its way with us. As frustrating as it is for us all, we ask that you remain patient, and vigilant as the Community Board office works with local agencies to keep our streets safe and clean. As a homeowner, by law you are required to do your part as well. Whether you're the owner, tenant, occupant or the person in charge of any lot or building, you must clear the snow and/or ice from your sidewalk within 4 hours after the snow has stopped falling, or by 11 a.m. if the snow stopped falling after 9 p.m. the night before. Remember to keep hydrants free of snow, and also remember not to throw snow into the streets. This is illegal, and you can get fined for doing so! 
