As a Queens Zoo Discovery Guide, You will help maintain a friendly atmosphere for zoo visitors by interpreting animal exhibit areas, assisting with birthday parties and special events, and facilitating crafts and games around the zoo.

Spring 2017 Discovery Guide Requirements:

- Training sessions for spring teens will take place at the Queens Zoo on March 11, 2017, March 18, 2017, March 25, 2017, and April 1, 2017 from 12 pm-5pm.
- Volunteers must commit to 1 weekend volunteer day (9:30-4:00) each week from March through the end of June 2017. Volunteers are also needed during public school spring recess (April 10-18).
- Participants must be 14 years old as of March 11th in order to apply. In addition to the application, **ALL HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A TEACHER SUBMIT A LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION.**
