A word from the District Manager

Dear Members and Residents of Queens CB4,

As we enter the cold season (again), we have to remember not to overlook all the unforeseen dangers that come to light when the temperature drops.

Winter (specifically January) is the deadliest time for carbon monoxide poisoning. This is primarily due to the fact that many of us are careless in how we heat our homes. In an effort to save money, believe it or not, many people use alternative heating measures such as charcoal, stoves, grills, etc.. I cannot emphasize enough how dangerous this is.

- * Have your heating system, water heater and any other gas, oil or coal-burning appliance inspected and serviced by a qualified technician
- * Install battery-operated CO detectors on every level of your home.
- * Don't use a generator, charcoal grill, camp stove or other gasoline or charcoal-burning device inside the home, basement or garage or outside the home near a window.
- * Don't burn anything in an unvented stove or fireplace.
- * Don't let a vehicle idle inside a garage attached to a house, even if the garage door is left open.
- * Don't heat a house with a gas oven.

Please make sure not to overlook the symptoms of CO poisoning such as headaches, dizziness, nausea or confusion. While some of these may be common, they may be a sign of something more serious. Leave the room immediately, and **call 911.**
