8 Ways to Stay Cool while Saving Money

1. **Consider a Fan instead of AC During Peak Hours.**
 Fans use electricity, but only 1/10 of the electricity produced by an AC. That’s about \$100 per month!
2. **Create a Cross Current**
 By opening windows that are across from each other, you will create a wind tunnel effect.
3. **Keep a Spray Bottle in the Refrigerator and Spritz Yourself Throughout the Day.**
 As the cool water evaporates, your body will cool down. Concentrate sprays on your wrists and back of your neck.
4. **Program your Thermostat.**
 The best way to save is NOT by turning your AC on and off as the house heats and cool. This makes your unit run double time. Set your thermostat to 76 while home, and 85 when you’re away.
5. **Draw the Blinds During the Day/When you are not Home.**
 It’s always cooler in the shade. Drawing blinds prevents sun from heating up your home. Lighter shades work better than darker ones. Darker ones retain heat.
6. **Cook Outside.**
 Summer barbecues will help you to take advantage of the cooler weather, and keep the heat where it belongs...Outside.
7. **Check your Seals.**
 Don’t let cool air escape. Leaky windows and doors should be checked for drafts. Replace seals with a fresh coat of caulking around your windows, and new weather stripping around the doors.
8. **Cool down your Showers.**
 When you take a warm/hot shower, you’re raising your body temperature. By cooling down the temperature of your water, you’re cooling down the temperature of your body. Stay cool = sweat less.
