CORONA COMMUNITY AMBULANCE CORP.

Starting Monday, December 14, 2009 the Corona Community Ambulance Corps, Inc. rolled out a guaranteed tour. That is to say, everyday from now on the Ambulance Corp. will be running, with 100% assurance, an ambulance for the community staffed by Corona members between the hours of 8 am and 8 pm. In addition, we will continue to run our off-hour units (between 8 pm and 8 am) but those will be subject to change based on member availability. The 8 am to 8 pm crew will always be on duty. Someone will be at the base (either a dispatcher or the crew themselves) should any resident call 718-592-1068. Obviously, if the crew is on a community call, they cannot handle multiple assignments but we will respond to the next assignment as soon as we come available. Our dispatchers will receive the call, assign the ambulance or call in a backup unit, to meet the needs.

We are finalizing the expansion of area paperwork with the City and State and we are working on political support. What I want to do is ensure to CB4Q that we are making every effort to be there for the community. 8 am to 8 pm is the highest call volume for the community and we want to ensure to the residents and businesses that we are there to help.

Officially, we are only allowed by law to operate within Corona but because there is no agency currently covering Elmhurst, we can respond if we are called in by a resident. We want to complete the expansion of area process so there is no question as to our primary operating territory. As part of the expansion of area, we are working to get NYS DOH approval (which we seem in line to get) for all of CB #4Q and CB #3Q.

SANITATION BEGINS WINTER NIGHT PLOW SCHEDULE

The Department of Sanitation began its Annual Night Plow Operation that enables the Department to respond promptly and effectively to snow and ice conditions around the clock.

The seasonal change will assure that the Department will have a sufficient number of employees assigned to work the night shifts in each of the city's 59 Sanitation Districts so that a trained and experienced workforce is available to operate essential snow fighting equipment on the night and early morning shifts. These two shifts are 4:00pm to Midnight and Midnight to 8:00am. The day shift starts at 6:00am.

The Department's snow season runs from November through mid-April.

The Department has a front line defense of 365 salt spreaders that are dispatched prior to the start of the impending snowfall to salt arterial highways and bus routes. The Department has a storage capacity of 235,000 tons of rock salt, and 360,700 gallons of calcium chloride deicing solution at 47 facilities throughout the city. Once snow begins to accumulate on the City's streets and highways, approximately 2,000 plows are mounted on various DSNY trucks in order to clear snow from the City's more than 6,000 curb miles of streets.

When the Department is not handling snow and ice situations, night shift Sanitation Workers will collect household refuse and recycling. As a result, some neighborhoods may experience minor inconveniences. Night collection crews have been advised to work as quietly as possible.
