PUBLIC HEARING #1**NYC Department of Transportation**

Change the direction of traffic flow on Lamont Avenue between Gleane Street and 41st Avenue from a two-way operation to a one-way operation in Elmhurst, Queens.

NYC Department of Transportation (DOT) investigated and concluded that a conversion to a one-way operation northbound for Lamont Avenue between Gleane Street and 41st Avenue would improve safety for pedestrians and motorists and alleviate congestion in the area. The narrow roadway, coupled with parking on both sides of the street, makes it very difficult for two opposing vehicles to pass each other. DOT indicated that Lamont Avenue between 43rd Avenue and Gleane Street is already operating as a one-way northbound Street.

Therefore DOT recommends that we convert the remaining length of Lamont Avenue between Gleane Street and 41st Avenue to make the entire segment of Lamont Avenue one-way northbound.
