SUMMER YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM (SYEP)

1. What is the Summer Youth Employment Program (SYEP)?

SYEP is a job program that provides youth between the ages of 14 – 24 years old with work experience, life skills training and income during the summer months and qualified organizations with free summer help.

2. When will SYEP start?

SYEP is a seven week program that will begin on Tuesday, July 6, 2010 and continue through Saturday, August 21, 2010.

APPLYING FOR SYEP

1. How do I qualify for SYEP?

To be eligible for SYEP, you must be at least 14 years old but not over 24 years old as of the start of the program on July 6, 2010. You must also permanently reside within the five boroughs of New York City.

2. When will the SYEP applications be available?

SYEP applications are available starting April 19, 2010. Application deadline is May 21, 2010.

3. How do I apply for SYEP?

Visit www.nyc.gov/dycd and complete the application online. You can also download and print a copy of the application, complete it and return it to a community-based SYEP Provider.
