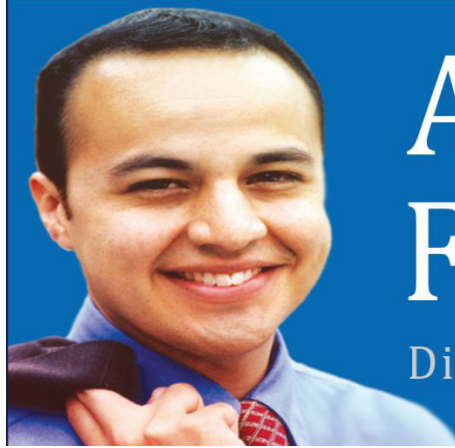

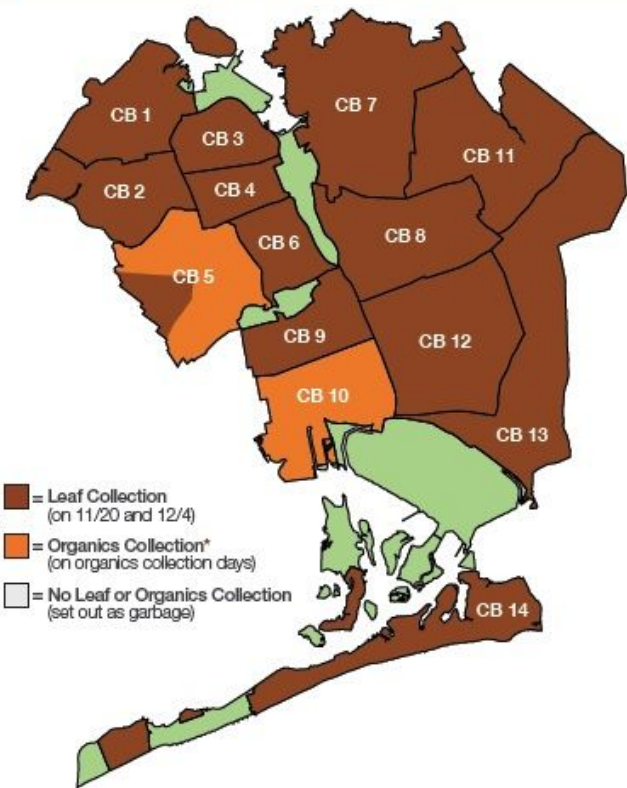
HOW TO PARTICIPATE

- 1** Collect your leaves in paper lawn & leaf bags or open, unlined containers.
- 2** Set leaves out for collection at the curb after 4pm the night before your collection dates.
- 3** Sanitation will collect your leaves for composting!

TIP: Find where to buy lawn & leaf bags: nyc.gov/yardwaste.

- No Plastic bags.** Yard waste set out in plastic bags will be collected as garbage.
- No Wood debris (branches) in Brooklyn and Queens.** You must notify Parks Department due to Asian Long-Horned Beetle quarantine; call 311 or visit on.nyc.gov/wood-debris.
- No Branches & yard clippings from hired professionals.** Landscapers must dispose of yard waste at a permitted composting facility.
