E-ZPass Phishing Scam

The MTA has issued a warning that an email going around to E-ZPass holders is actually a phishing scam. The email, which looks as though it was sent by the E-ZPass service center, asks customers to download an invoice with a list of unpaid tolls. (Hint: don't do that.)

Statement from the New York State Thruway Authority

People have received bogus emails made to appear official stating that people have unpaid tolls.

"Please be advised this is not an authorized communication from E-ZPass, the New York State Thruway Authority or any other toll agency associated with E-ZPass," the Thruway Authority said in a statement. "We advise you not to open or respond to such a message should you receive one."

The bogus email includes a clickable link to download a supposed invoice. Do not click the link or respond to the email.
