

**Quarterly Report on Homeless Deaths #3**  
**New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene**  
**Bureau of Vital Statistics**  
**Local Law 63 of 2005**  
**January 1, 2006 - March 31, 2006**

This report has been prepared and submitted pursuant to Local Law 63 of 2005 (LL63) amending the Administrative Code of the City of New York, in relation to requiring the New York City (NYC) Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH) to track and report deaths of homeless persons in the City of New York. This is the third deliverable prepared under the law, which requires quarterly and annual reports. Data contained in this report are for the period January 1, 2006 - March 31, 2006 and were provided by the NYC Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), the NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS), the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) and the NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA) to the DOHMH. DHS, HPD and HRA maintain records on the homeless individuals for whom they provide temporary housing in New York City. OCME, through its responsibilities investigating NYC deaths, investigates the deaths of some homeless individuals. Data from these agencies and OCME were compiled, matched against NYC death certificates and analyzed by the DOHMH's Office of Vital Statistics and is presented herein.

As defined in LL63, a "homeless person" is "a person who at the time of death did not have a known street address of a residence at which he or she was known or reasonably believed to have resided." A "homeless shelter resident" is "a person who at the time of death lived in a homeless shelter..." A "homeless shelter" is "(i) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of homeless services; (ii) an emergency residence operated by or on behalf of the department of social services/human resources administration which is available primarily for homeless persons with HIV or AIDS related illness; or (iii) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of housing preservation and development to the extent that such residence houses clients of the department of homeless services; provided, however, that such term shall not include any residence that is available primarily for battered women."

Based on definitions above, incident reports were provided by OCME, DHS and HPD. Information from corresponding NYC death certificates were used to validate agency reports and remove any duplicates among them (i.e. some DHS cases were also OCME cases). Data from HRA did not disclose any identifiable information on HRA homeless residents, per Article 27-F of the New York State Public Health Law, which prohibits disclosure of information that could reasonably identify someone as having an HIV-related illness or AIDS. *Therefore, corresponding death certificates for HRA-reported homeless deaths could not be identified and may duplicate reports from OCME.*

## **DEATHS TO HOMELESS PERSONS AND HOMELESS SHELTER RESIDENTS**

### ***Reported Homeless Deaths***

OCME, DHS and HPD reported a total of 42 homeless deaths between January 1 and March 31, 2006, a decrease from 59 deaths reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Of the total reported, 37 were investigated by OCME.

Twenty of the 42 deaths occurred in Manhattan, 2 in the Bronx, 16 in Brooklyn, 3 in Queens, and

none in Staten Island. One additional DHS resident lived in a DHS-operated shelter located outside of New York City and died in a nearby hospital. This death, having occurred outside of NYC, is not a NYC event and was not reported on a NYC death certificate, nor will primary investigation be conducted by NYC OCME.

HRA reported 13 homeless deaths this quarter as compared to 12 reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Among the 13 HRA deaths reported, 7 were in Manhattan, 1 was in the Bronx and 4 were in Brooklyn; the borough for one HRA death was reported as unknown. No homeless deaths were reported in the Queens or Staten Island by HRA. Location of death is only one of several elements that is requested of HRA staff, and they are reminded to make every effort to ascertain where the client died at the time they become aware of a client's death.

#### Decedent Shelter Residency Status and Shelter Location

Among the 42 OCME, DHS and HPD-reported homeless deaths 24 (57%) reported to have been a resident of a shelter system at the time of death; 18 (43%) were not. Of the 24 sheltered homeless decedents identified by OCME, DHS and HPD, 12 were sheltered in Manhattan, 1 in the Bronx, 8 in Brooklyn, 1 in Queens, none in Staten Island and 1 outside of NYC. The shelter location of 1 other sheltered resident was reported as unknown (Table 2).

Please note that HRA reports "homeless" residents as living in Single Room Occupancies (SROs). SROs are not homeless shelters. These decedents had been provided with temporary emergency housing and according to LL63 definitions, are classified as homeless sheltered residents.

#### Homeless Decedents Investigated by OCME

Among the 42 homeless deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD, most (37 or 88%) were investigated by OCME; 5 (12%) were not. Four of the five not investigated by OCME were deaths due to natural causes and therefore were not OCME cases. The fifth occurred to a DHS resident, but the shelter and location of death were outside of New York City. Deaths occurring outside NYC do not fall within the jurisdiction of OCME. Among the 24 sheltered, 19 (79%) were investigated by OCME, 5 (21%) were not; among the 18 non-sheltered, all were investigated by OCME (Table 1).

#### Homeless Decedent Location of Death by Borough and Community District

The locations of death (i.e., in shelter, in a hospital, outdoors or other), disaggregated by borough, community district and shelter residency status are shown in Table 3. HRA's homeless deaths by location of death are presented separately in Table 4 by borough only, as required by LL63. Please note that deaths of persons in nursing homes are currently not included in the tables as we have not had any reports of death in nursing homes through March 2006. Nursing Homes are generally considered permanent placements; homeless sheltered clients are generally not placed in nursing homes. Nursing homes, if releasing homeless clients, are responsible for placing them in permanent housing. As a result, we do not anticipate homeless death reports that have occurred in Nursing Homes from any of our reporting agencies. If and when we do receive such a report, the category will be added to the tables.

Among the 42 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 5 (12%) occurred at a shelter, 22 (52%) in a hospital, 10 (24%) outdoors and 5 (12%) in an "other" location. Among the 10 outdoor deaths, 1 was in Manhattan, none were in the Bronx, 8 were in Brooklyn, and 1 was in Queens; 4 were found on the street, 2 on the boardwalk, 2 in a vacant lot, 1 in a park area and 1 outdoors near the train.

Among the 5 “other” deaths, 2 were in Manhattan and three were in Brooklyn; two were found in buildings, two in the subway and one in a vacant apartment.

More non-sheltered residents died outdoors than sheltered residents. The distribution of location of death among the 24 sheltered homeless decedents is as follows: 16 died in the hospital, 5 died at the homeless shelter, 2 were found “outdoors” - 1 on the street and 1 near a subway outdoors – and one died in “other” circumstances in a vacant apartment of an abandoned building.

The distribution of location of death among the 18 non-sheltered and sheltered status-unknown decedents is as follows: 6 died in the hospital, 8 died “outdoors” – 3 found in the street, 2 found on the boardwalk, 2 in a vacant lot and 1 in a park area – and 4 died in “other” circumstances – 2 in buildings and 2 in the train or subway (Table 3).

All 13 of the HRA-reported homeless persons’ deaths were residents of SRO housing and as such defined as sheltered, when they died. Six were reported as dying in the hospital, 1 in an HRA emergency housing facility (shelter) and the location of 6 others was reported as unknown.

*Deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD cannot be added to deaths reported by HRA. As stated above, death certificates for HRA-reported homeless persons’ deaths may not be identified by law and may duplicate reports from OCME.*

#### Homeless Decedents’ Age and Gender by Borough and Community District

Of the 42 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 36 (86%) were males and 6 (14%) were females (Table 5). Four (9%) were less than 24 years of age and included two infants, each just over 1 month of age. Both infants were male, sheltered residents and are under investigation by OCME.

Thirteen (31%) of the remaining homeless decedents were between 25 and 44 years of age, 21 (50%) were between 45 and 64 years of age and 4 (10%) were older than 65 years of age.

Among the 36 male homeless decedents, 2 were less than 24 years of age (the 2 infants mentioned above), 12 were between 25 and 44 years of age, 18 were between 45 and 64 years of age and 4 were older than 65 years of age. Among the 6 female homeless decedents, 2 were less than 24 years of age (not infants), 1 was between 25 and 44 years of age, 3 were between 45 and 64 years of age and none were older than 65 years of age. The age and gender distribution disaggregated by borough and community district are found in Table 5.

Among the 13 HRA homeless persons’ deaths, 10 (77%) were male and 3 (23%) were female. Six were between 25 and 44 years of age and 7 were between 45 and 64 years of age. The age and gender distribution by borough can be found in Table 6.

#### **NEXT STEPS**

Permissions to share data among OCME, DHS and HPD should be resolved by the Fall, 2006. Exchange of data to resolve duplication will then be conducted for all year one data and presented in the first annual report due in January, 2007. The data sharing agreement is circulating for comment among the agencies and their respective legal departments. As noted in the previous report, manual matching to New York City death certificates has resolved duplicates and confirmed OCME investigation – in those situations when death was reported by DHS or HPD but not by OCME. We are currently working on developing new tables that will provide some cumulative data on homeless deaths for future reporting.

To comply with Article 27-F of the New York state Public Health Law which prohibits disclosure of any information that could reasonably identify someone having an HIV related illness or AIDS, personal identifiers on HRA homeless deaths were not provided; hence corresponding death certificates could not be reviewed to determine whether deaths were also reported by OCME
