

Quarterly Report on Homeless Deaths # 8
New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene
Bureau of Vital Statistics
Local Law 63 of 2005
April 1, 2007 – June 30, 2007

Introduction. This report has been prepared and submitted pursuant to Local Law 63 of 2005 (LL63) amending the Administrative Code of the City of New York to track and report deaths of homeless persons in the City of New York. Data contained in this report are for the quarter period of April 1, 2007 – June 30, 2007 and were provided by the NYC Office of the Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), the NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS), the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) and the NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA) to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH).

DHS, HPD and HRA maintain records on the homeless individuals for whom they provide temporary housing in New York City. OCME, through its responsibilities investigating NYC deaths, investigates the deaths of some homeless individuals. Data from these agencies were compiled, matched against NYC death certificates and analyzed by the DOHMH Office of Vital Statistics and is presented herein.

Definitions. As defined in LL63, a “homeless person” is a person who at the time of death did not have a known street address of a residence at which he or she was known or reasonably believed to have resided. A “homeless shelter resident” is “a person who at the time of death lived in a homeless shelter. A “homeless shelter” is “(i) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of homeless services; (ii) an emergency residence operated by or on behalf of the department of social services/human resources administration which is available primarily for homeless persons with HIV or AIDS related illness; or (iii) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of housing preservation and development to the extent that such residence houses clients of the department of homeless services; provided, however that such term shall not include any residence that is available primarily for battered women.”


Methods. Based on definitions above, incident reports were provided by OCME, DHS and HPD. Information from corresponding NYC death certificates were used to validate agency reports and remove any duplicates among them (i.e. when DHS cases are also OCME cases). HRA did not disclose any identifiable information on HRA homeless residents, per Article 27-F of the New York State Public Health Law, which prohibits disclosure of information that could reasonably identify someone as having an HIV-related illness or AIDS. As a result HRA homeless deaths cannot be combined with DHS, HPD and OCME deaths and total NYC homeless deaths cannot be ascertained.

DEATHS OF HOMELESS PERSONS AND HOMELESS SHELTER RESIDENTS

Reported Homeless Deaths

OCME, DHS and HPD reported a total of 34 homeless deaths between April 1 and June 30, 2007. Of the total reported this quarter, all were investigated by OCME. On average, over the previous 7 quarters, 37 deaths have been reported per quarter. Deaths ranged from 24 to 57 during the previous 7 quarters. There were 43 deaths last quarter.

The trend chart below looks at deaths over all 8 quarters. Quarters 1-4 were included in the first annual report. The data for quarters 5-8 are preliminary, and the numbers may change with late reporting. Any changes in quarters 5-8 will be reflected in the second annual report, which will be released in January 2008.



Fifteen of the 34 deaths occurred in Manhattan, 7 in the Bronx, 9 in Brooklyn, 2 in Queens, and 1 in Staten Island.

HRA reported 12 homeless deaths this quarter as compared to 15 reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Among the 12 HRA deaths reported, 2 were in Manhattan, 6 in the Bronx, 4 in Brooklyn, none in Queens, and none in Staten Island.

Decedent Shelter Residency Status and Shelter Location

Among the 34 OCME, DHS and HPD-reported homeless deaths, 20 (59%) were reported to have been a resident of a shelter system at the time of death, 14 (41%) were not sheltered (Table 1). The proportion of sheltered homeless decedents has varied ranging from 35% to 86% during the previous 7 quarters. Of the 20 sheltered homeless decedents identified by OCME, DHS and HPD this quarter, 8 were sheltered in Manhattan, 4 in Bronx, 6 in Brooklyn, 2 in Queens, and none in Staten Island (Table 2).

Please note that HRA reports “homeless” residents as living in Single Room Occupancies (SROs). SROs are not homeless shelters. These decedents had been provided with temporary

emergency housing and according to LL63 definition, are classified as homeless sheltered residents.

Homeless Decedents Investigated by OCME

Among the 34 homeless deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD, all were investigated by OCME (Table 1). This is the first quarter, since the report was initiated in 2005, where 100% of homeless deaths were investigated by OCME. As a result of the initiatives discussed in the first annual report, a Memorandum of Understanding between DHS and DOHMH and enhanced communication amongst OCME, DHS, and DOHMH, OCME now notifies DHS in real time of every suspected homeless death. This notification system was initiated in February 2007.

Homeless Decedent Location of Death by Borough and Community District

The location of OCME, DHS and HPD reported deaths (i.e. in shelter, in a hospital, outdoors or other), disaggregated by borough, community district and shelter residency status are shown in Table 3. HRA homeless deaths by location of death are presented separately in Table 4 by borough only, as required by LL63.

Among the 34 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 6 (18%) occurred at a shelter, 18 (53%) in a hospital, 7 (21%) outdoors and 3 (9%) in an "other" location. The number of homeless decedents who died outdoors has ranged from 3 to 20 decedents per quarter over the previous 7 quarterly reports. Those who died in other locations ranged from 1 to 11 decedents per quarter in the same time period. Among the 7 outdoor deaths reported this quarter, 4 were in Manhattan, 1 in the Bronx, 2 in Brooklyn, none in Queens, and none in Staten Island. One was found dead in the subway or train, 1 outside a building, 1 in a parking lot, 2 in a trailer or van, 2 in a park or wooded area. Among the 3 other location deaths, 1 died in Manhattan, 1 in the Bronx and 1 in Staten Island. One died in a family member's apartment, 1 in a hotel, and 1 in a detention center.

The distribution of location of death among the 20 sheltered homeless decedents was as follows: 13 died in the hospital, 6 died at the homeless shelter and 1 was found outdoors – outside a building (Table 3).

The distribution of location among the 14 non-sheltered was as follows: 5 died in a hospital, 6 outdoors and 3 in other locations. Among the 6 non-sheltered outdoor deaths, 1 was found dead in the subway or train, 1 in a parking lot, 2 in a trailer or van, 2 in a park or wooded area. The 3 other deaths were all non-sheltered and locations are described above.

All 12 of the HRA-reported homeless persons' deaths were residents of SRO housing and as such defined as sheltered, when they died. Five were reported as dying in the hospital, 7 in an HRA emergency housing facility (shelter), and none in unknown locations (Table 4).

Deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD cannot be added to deaths reported by HRA. As stated above, death certificates for HRA-reported homeless persons' deaths may not be identified by law and may duplicate reports from OCME.

Homeless Decedents' Age and Gender by Borough and Community District

Of the 34 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 26 (76%) were male and 8 (24%) were female (Table 5). One (3%) was an infant, female, 2 months old. The infant was a sheltered resident and was investigated by OCME.

One (3%, female) of the 34 decedents was between the ages of 1 and 24 years, 6 (18%, all male) were between the ages of 25 and 44 years, another 23 (68%, 17 male and 6 female) were between the ages of 45 and 64 years, and 3 (9%, all male) were older than 65 years of age.

Of the 12 HRA homeless decedents, 9 (75%) were male and 3 (25%) were female. All were between 25 and 64 years of age. The age and gender distribution by borough can be found in Table 6.

Comments

The data sharing between DHS and DOHMH, including OCME notification to DHS of suspected homeless deaths in real time, has led to improved and more comprehensive reporting. Consequently, this quarter was the first one where OCME investigated 100% of DHS homeless deaths. Moving forward, there are other issues to consider. In particular, the second annual report will examine differences over quarters 5-8, between the location where the decedent was found unresponsive and the location where the decedent was pronounced dead. With outdoor deaths, this distinction is important. For instance, one person in this report was found unresponsive outdoors, and resuscitative efforts at the scene were unsuccessful. The decedent was then taken to the hospital where efforts continued, still unsuccessful, and the decedent was pronounced dead. This report defines location of death as the location where the decedent was pronounced dead, as stated in the death certificate and OCME incident reports. However the location where the decedent was found unresponsive warrants further consideration.

DOHMH is currently pursuing a Memorandum of Understanding with HRA that would enable DOHMH to identify death certificates for HRA reported homeless persons. Aggregate statistics summarizing all homeless deaths (DHS, HPD, OCME, and HRA combined) could then be reported.

HRA homeless sheltered deaths are reported separately and should not be added to other homeless sheltered deaths as there may be duplication. To comply with Article 27-F of the New York state Public Health Law which prohibits disclosure of any information that could reasonably identify someone having an HIV related illness or AIDS, personal identifiers on HRA homeless deaths were not provided; hence corresponding death certificates could not be reviewed to determine whether deaths were also reported by OCME.
