

**Quarterly Report on Homeless Deaths # 10**  
**New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene**  
**Bureau of Vital Statistics**  
**Local Law 63 of 2005**  
**October 1, 2007 – December 31, 2007**

**Introduction.** This report has been prepared and submitted pursuant to Local Law 63 of 2005 (LL63) amending the Administrative Code of the City of New York to track and report deaths of homeless persons in the City of New York. Data contained in this report are for the quarter period of October 1, 2007 – December 31, 2007 and were provided by the NYC Office of Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), the NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS), the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD) and the NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA) to the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH).

DHS, HPD and HRA maintain records on the homeless individuals for whom they provide temporary housing in New York City. OCME, through its responsibilities investigating NYC deaths, investigates the deaths of some homeless individuals. Data from these agencies were compiled, matched against NYC death certificates and analyzed by the DOHMH Office of Vital Statistics and are presented herein.

**Definitions.** As defined in LL63, a “homeless person” is a person who at the time of death did not have a known street address of a residence at which he or she was known or reasonably believed to have resided. A “homeless shelter resident” is “a person who at the time of death lived in a homeless shelter. A “homeless shelter” is “(i) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of homeless services; (ii) an emergency residence operated by or on behalf of the department of social services/human resources administration which is available primarily for homeless persons with HIV or AIDS related illness; or (iii) a residence operated by or on behalf of the department of housing preservation and development to the extent that such residence houses clients of the department of homeless services; provided, however that such term shall not include any residence that is available primarily for battered women.”


**Methods.** Based on definitions above, incident reports were provided by OCME, DHS and HPD. Information from corresponding NYC death certificates were used to validate agency reports and remove any duplicates among them (i.e. when DHS cases are also OCME cases). HRA did not disclose any identifiable information on HRA homeless residents, per Article 27-F of the New York State Public Health Law, which prohibits disclosure of information that could reasonably identify someone as having an HIV-related illness or AIDS. As a result HRA homeless deaths cannot be combined with DHS, HPD and OCME deaths and total NYC homeless deaths cannot be ascertained.

## DEATHS OF HOMELESS PERSONS AND HOMELESS SHELTER RESIDENTS

### Reported Homeless Deaths

OCME, DHS and HPD reported a total of 51 homeless deaths between October 1 and December 31, 2007. This quarter’s total is the second highest since this report was initiated; the highest (57) was reported for the same time period (October 1 – December 31) in 2005. In 2006, 22 deaths were reported for this time period. Of the total reported this quarter, 45 were investigated by OCME. On average, over the previous 9 quarters, 37 deaths have been reported per quarter. Deaths have ranged from 22 to 57 during the previous 9 quarters. There were 33 deaths last quarter.

The trend chart below looks at deaths over all 10 quarters. Quarters 1-4 were included in the first annual report, and quarters 5-8 were included in the second annual report. The data for quarters 9 and 10 are preliminary, and the numbers may change with late reporting. Any changes in these and future quarters will be reflected in the annual report.



Twenty-four of the 51 deaths occurred in Manhattan, 4 in the Bronx, 13 in Brooklyn, 10 in Queens, and none in Staten Island.

HRA reported 9 homeless deaths this quarter as compared to 12 reported in the previous quarter (Table 1). Among the 9 HRA deaths reported, 3 were in Manhattan, 4 in the Bronx, 1 in Brooklyn, none in Queens, none in Staten Island, and 1 in an unknown borough.

### Decedent Shelter Residency Status and Shelter Location

Among the 51 OCME, DHS and HPD-reported homeless deaths, 18 (35%) were reported to have been a resident of a shelter system at the time of death, and 33 (65%) were not sheltered (Table 1). Of the 18 sheltered, 6 died in Manhattan, 2 in the Bronx, 7 in Brooklyn, 3 in Queens, and none in

Staten Island. Of the 33 unsheltered, 18 died in Manhattan, 2 in the Bronx, 6 in Brooklyn, 7 in Queens, and none in Staten Island.

The percent of sheltered decedents over total decedents has ranged from 35% to 86% during the previous 9 quarters. Of the 18 sheltered homeless decedents identified by OCME, DHS and HPD this quarter, 6 were sheltered in Manhattan, 1 in the Bronx, 7 in Brooklyn, 4 in Queens, and none in Staten Island (Table 2).

Please note that HRA reports “homeless” residents as living in Single Room Occupancies (SROs). SROs are not homeless shelters. These decedents had been provided with temporary emergency housing and, according to LL63 definition, are classified as homeless sheltered residents.

#### Homeless Decedents Investigated by OCME

Among the 51 homeless deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD, 45 (88%) were investigated by OCME (Table 1). The OCME investigated 67% of the sheltered homeless deaths, and 100% of the unsheltered homeless deaths. While the percent of deaths investigated by the OCME fluctuates, communication amongst OCME, DHS, and DOHMH has improved. As a result of the initiatives discussed in the first annual report, a Memorandum of Understanding between DHS and DOHMH was signed to permit detailed data sharing. OCME also notifies DHS in real time of every suspected homeless death.

#### Homeless Decedent Location of Death by Borough and Community District

The location of OCME, DHS and HPD-reported deaths (i.e. in shelter, in a hospital, outdoors or other), disaggregated by borough, community district and shelter residency status, are shown in Table 3. HRA homeless deaths by location of death are presented separately in Table 4 by borough only, as required by LL63.

Among the 51 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 3 (6%) occurred at a shelter, 26 (51%) in a hospital, 12 (24%) outdoors and 10 (20%) in an “other” location. The number of homeless decedents who died outdoors has ranged from 3 to 20 decedents per quarter over the previous 9 quarterly reports. Those who died in “other” locations have ranged from 1 to 11 decedents per quarter. Among the 12 outdoor deaths reported this quarter, 7 were in Manhattan, 1 in the Bronx, 1 in Brooklyn, and 3 were in Queens. Among the 10 “other” location deaths, 5 died in Manhattan, 2 in Brooklyn, and 3 died in Queens.

The distribution of location of death among the 18 sheltered homeless decedents was as follows: 11 died in the hospital, 3 died at the homeless shelter, 3 died outdoors, and 1 in an “other” location (Table 3). Among the 3 sheltered outdoor deaths, 1 was found on the street, 1 in the river, and 1 on the shore. The 1 “other” death was subway-related, and found on subway tracks.

The distribution of location of death among the 33 non-sheltered was as follows: 15 died in a hospital, 9 outdoors and 9 in “other” locations. Among the 9 non-sheltered outdoor deaths, 3 were found on the street, 2 in vacant lots, 2 in parks, 1 in a marshy area, and 1 on a bridge. Among the 9 “other” deaths, 4 were subway-related (3 on subway tracks, and 1 in a subway station), 2 in building basements (1 apartment building and 1 restaurant), 1 in a vacant home, 1 in a friend’s apartment, and 1 in a public library.

This quarter shows the highest reported number of subway-related deaths at 5. This is followed by 4 reported in the seventh report (January – March 2007); less than 3 subway-related deaths have been reported quarterly otherwise.

All 9 of the HRA-reported homeless persons' deaths were residents of SRO housing and as such defined as sheltered, when they died. Three were reported as dying in the hospital, 4 in an HRA emergency housing facility (shelter), 1 in an "other" location (struck by a subway train), and 1 in an unknown location (Table 4).

*Deaths reported by OCME, DHS and HPD cannot be added to deaths reported by HRA. As stated above, death certificates for HRA-reported homeless persons' deaths may not be identified by law and may duplicate reports from OCME.*

#### Homeless Decedents' Age and Gender by Borough and Community District

Of the 51 OCME, DHS and HPD deaths, 39 (76%) were male and 12 (24%) were female (Table 5). One (2%) was an infant, female, 6 weeks old. The infant was a sheltered resident and was investigated by OCME.

Three (6%, 1 male and 2 female) of the 51 decedents were between the ages of 1 and 24 years, and 13 (25%, 10 male and 3 female) were between the ages of 25 and 44 years. Another 27 (53%, 22 male and 5 female) were between the ages of 45 and 64 years, 6 (12%, 5 male and 1 female) were older than 65 years of age, and 1 (2%, male) was of unknown age.

Of the 9 HRA homeless decedents, 6 (67%) were male and 3 (33%) were female. Eight (89%, 5 male and 3 female) were between 25 and 64 years of age, and 1 (11%, 1 male) was older than 65 years of age. The age and gender distribution by borough is shown in Table 6.

HRA homeless sheltered deaths are reported separately and should not be added to other homeless sheltered deaths as there may be duplication. To comply with Article 27-F of the New York state Public Health Law which prohibits disclosure of any information that could reasonably identify someone having an HIV related illness or AIDS, personal identifiers on HRA homeless deaths were not provided; hence corresponding death certificates could not be reviewed to determine whether deaths were also reported by OCME.
