What is The Housing Subsidy Program?

-  The Housing Subsidy Program is a rent subsidy program administered by ACS, for the purpose of reuniting foster care children with their families or preventing the placement of children into foster care.
-  Housing Subsidy pays up to \$300.00 monthly, directly to your landlord.
-  Housing Subsidy can pay up to \$1800.00 if you owe back rent to your current landlord.
-  We also pay Broker's Fee and Security Deposits, even for families who have Section 8, NYCHA, or Public Assistance.

What does The Housing Subsidy Program Provide?

-  A Monthly Rent Supplement
-  Broker's Fee
-  Security Deposits
-  Furniture
-  Moving Expenses . . .
-  . . . and many other one time expenses needed to establish a safe and comfortable home for your family.
