

**Quarterly Report on Homeless Deaths # 17**  
**New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene**  
**Bureau of Vital Statistics**  
**Local Law 63 of 2005**  
**July 1, 2009 –September 30, 2009**

**Introduction.** This report has been prepared and submitted pursuant to Local Law 63 of 2005 (LL63) amending the Administrative Code of the City of New York to track and report deaths of homeless persons in the City of New York. Data contained in this report are for the quarter period of July 1, 2009 – September 30, 2009 and were provided by the NYC Office of Chief Medical Examiner (OCME), the NYC Department of Homeless Services (DHS), the NYC Department of Housing Preservation and Development (HPD), and the NYC Human Resources Administration (HRA) to the NYC Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH).

DHS, HPD, and HRA maintain records on the homeless individuals for whom they provide temporary housing in New York City. OCME, through its responsibilities investigating New York City deaths, investigates the deaths of some homeless individuals. Data from these agencies were compiled, matched against NYC death certificates and analyzed by the DOHMH Office of Vital Statistics and are presented herein.

**Definitions.** As defined in LL63, a “homeless person” is a person who at the time of death did not have a known street address of a residence at which he or she was known or reasonably believed to have resided. A “homeless shelter resident” is “a person who at the time of death lived in a homeless shelter. A “homeless shelter” is “(i) a residence operated by or on behalf of the Department of Homeless Services; (ii) an emergency residence operated by or on behalf of the Department of Social Services/Human Resources administration which is available primarily for homeless persons with HIV or AIDS related illness; or (iii) a residence operated by or on behalf of the Department of Housing Preservation and Development to the extent that such residence houses clients of the Department of Homeless Services; provided, however that such term shall not include any residence that is available primarily for battered women.”


**Methods.** Based on definitions above, incident reports were provided by DHS,HPD, and OCME. Information from corresponding NYC death certificates were used to validate agency reports and remove any duplicates among them (i.e. when DHS cases are also OCME cases). HRA did not disclose any identifiable information on HRA homeless residents, per Article 27-F of the New York State Public Health Law, which prohibits disclosure of information that could reasonably identify someone as having an HIV-related illness or AIDS. As a result, HRA homeless deaths cannot be combined with DHS, HPD, and OCME deaths and total NYC homeless deaths cannot be ascertained.

## DEATHS OF HOMELESS PERSONS AND HOMELESS SHELTER RESIDENTS

### Reported Homeless Deaths

The trend chart below displays deaths over the past 17 reporting quarters. First, second, third, and fourth annual reports include final data for quarters 1-4, 5-8, 9-12, and 13-16 respectively. The data for quarter 17 are preliminary, and may change with late reporting. These changes will be reflected in the annual report.

## FINDINGS FROM PREVIOUS REPORTS

### Last (16<sup>th</sup>) Quarter (Apr-Jun '09)

- There were 41 DHS, HPD, and OCME deaths last quarter.
- HRA reported 7 deaths during the last quarter.
- Out of the 41 deaths reported by DHS, HPD, and OCME, 19 (46%) were non-sheltered individuals and 22 (54%) were sheltered individuals. Twenty-three (56%) died in a hospital, 6 (15%) died in a shelter, 6 (15%) died outdoors, and 6 (15%) died in an “other” location.

### Previous 16 Quarters

- On average, 40 deaths have been reported per quarter by DHS, HPD, and OCME.
- The number per quarter has ranged from 22 to 61.
- On average, there have been 22 (51%) non-sheltered decedents and 18 (49%) sheltered decedents per quarter.
- On average, there have been 19 (48%) deaths in hospitals, 6 (15%) deaths in shelters, 9 (21%) deaths outdoors and 7 (15%) deaths in “other” locations per quarter.

## OVERALL FINDINGS FOR THE 17<sup>TH</sup> QUARTER

### **51 DHS, HPD, AND OCME HOMELESS DEATHS (Table 2)**

- 51 homeless deaths, reported by DHS, HPD, and OCME occurred between July 1 and September 30.
  - 18 (35%) occurred in Manhattan, 12 (24%) in the Bronx, 16 (31%) in Brooklyn, 4 (8%) in Queens, and 1 (2%) in Staten Island.
- 44 (86%) were investigated by OCME, which investigates persons who die in a suspicious or unusual manner, alone, in apparent good health, in a correctional facility, or from criminal violence and suicide. The OCME also investigates when an application is made for a permit to cremate the body of a deceased person. - 38 (75%) were male and 13 (25%) were female (Table 6).
  - 3 (6%, 2 male, 1 female) were under 1 year of age.
  - 7 (14%, 4 male, 3 female) were between the ages of 1 and 24.
  - 19 (37%, 14 male, 5 female) were between the ages of 25 and 44.
  - 19 (37%, 16 male, 3 female) were between the ages of 45 and 64.
  - 3 (6%, 2 male, 1 female) were 65 years old or over.
- 31 (61%) were deaths to non-sheltered homeless individuals.
- 20 (39%) were death to sheltered homeless individuals.

### **31 Homeless Deaths Among Non-Sheltered Individuals**

#### **31 (61%) NYC homeless deaths among non-sheltered (Table 2)**

- 13 (42%) died in Manhattan, 4 (13%) in the Bronx, 9 (29%) in Brooklyn, 4 (13%) in Queens, and 1 (3%) in Staten Island.
- 28 (90%) of the 31 homeless deaths among non-sheltered individuals were investigated by OCME.
- Of the 3 (10%) deaths among non-sheltered individuals not investigated by OCME, 2 were OCME claim-only cases and did not result in a full investigation. One was an infant that died of congenital illness in the hospital<sup>†</sup>.

#### **Location of 31 Homeless Deaths Among Non-Sheltered Individuals (Table 3)\***

- 12 (39%) died in a hospital.
- 13 (42%) died outdoors.
  - 1 was found on a construction site.
  - 1 was found on the porch of a building.
  - 1 was found on the roof of a building.
  - 1 was found behind a church.
  - 2 were found near an expressway.
  - 3 were found on a sidewalk or street.
  - 4 were found in a park area.
- 6 (19%) died in “other” locations.
  - 1 was found in a public space in a public building.
  - 1 was found on subway tracks.
  - 1 was found in an abandoned building.
  - 3 were found in a friend or family member’s apartment.

## **20 Homeless Deaths Among Sheltered Individuals**

### 20 (39%) NYC homeless deaths occurred among sheltered (Table 2)

- 5 (25%) died in Manhattan, 8 (40%) in the Bronx, 7 (35%) in Brooklyn, none in Queens and none in Staten Island.
- 16 (80%) of the 20 homeless deaths among sheltered individuals were investigated by OCME.

### Location of 20 Homeless Deaths Among Sheltered Individuals (Table 3)\*

- 9 (45%) died in the hospital.
- 7 (35%) died at the homeless shelter.
- 3 (15%) died outdoors.
  - 2 were found on the sidewalk or street.
  - 1 was found on the roof of a building.
- 1 (5%) died in an “other” location in a public space in a public building.

### Location of Shelters Among These 20 Homeless Deaths (Table 4)

- 6 (30%) in Manhattan
- 7 (35%) in the Bronx
- 7 (35%) in Brooklyn
- None in Queens
- None in Staten Island

## **10 HRA HOMELESS DEATHS (Table 5)**

- 10 homeless deaths were reported by HRA. As indicated in the methods section, HRA homeless deaths cannot be combined with DHS, HPD and OCME deaths and total NYC homeless deaths cannot be ascertained. The range of possible total homeless deaths for this quarter, including HRA deaths, is 51-61.
- All 10 of the HRA-reported homeless persons’ deaths were residents of SRO housing and as such defined as sheltered, when they died.
- Three (30%) were reported to have died in Manhattan, 4 (40%) in the Bronx, 2 (20%) in Brooklyn, 1 (10%) in Queens, and none in Staten Island.
- Eight (80%) were reported as dying in an HRA emergency housing facility (shelter), and 2 died in the hospital (20%).
- 8 (80%) were male and 2 (20%) were female. All 10 were between the ages 45 and 64 (Table 7).

HRA homeless sheltered deaths are reported separately and should not be added to other homeless sheltered deaths as there may be duplication. To comply with Article 27-F of the New York state Public Health Law which prohibits disclosure of any information that could reasonably identify someone having an HIV related illness or AIDS, personal identifiers on HRA homeless deaths were not provided; hence corresponding death certificates could not be reviewed to determine whether deaths were also reported by OCME.
