

THE NYC HUMAN RIGHTS LAW PROTECTS VICTIMS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE FROM EMPLOYMENT DISCRIMINATION.

YOU MAY BE:

ENTITLED TO UNPAID LEAVE FOR MEDICAL APPOINTMENTS/SOCIAL SERVICES, ATTORNEY CONSULTATIONS, AND COURT DATES.

ENTITLED TO UNPAID LEAVE TO MOVE AND GET SETTLED IN A NEW RESIDENCE.

REQUIRED TO PROVIDE PROOF THAT YOU ARE A VICTIM.

YOUR EMPLOYER MAY NOT:

RELEASE ANY OF THE INFORMATION YOU PROVIDE EXCEPT WHEN DISCLOSURE IS REQUIRED BY APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL LAW.

FIRE YOU, REFUSE TO HIRE YOU, OR OTHERWISE DISCRIMINATE IN TERMS OR CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT BASED ON YOUR STATUS AS A VICTIM.
