Have you ever experienced discrimination when renting an apartment?

Buying a home? Getting a mortgage?

If you have disability, is your building accessible?

It is against the law to discriminate in housing based on:

race

disability

alienage & citizenship status

marital status

partnership status

familial status

(families with children)

lawful occupation

age

sexual orientation

gender

(including gender identity and sexual harassment)

creed

lawful source of income

(including Section 8 vouchers)

color

national origin

The NYC Commission on Human Rights staff are available to meet with you, your group, business or housing association to talk about Fair Housing Protections and disability rights.

The Commission is a HUD-approved Housing Counseling Agency and provides one-on-one mortgage counseling as a free service for families or individuals in danger of losing their homes to foreclosure.
