JOB DESCRIPTION:

Under the supervision of the Director of IT Applications, with broad scope for independent initiative and judgment, the IT Developer/Database Administrator performs tasks related to the development of .Net, Cold Fusion software applications. Duties include, but are not limited to developing, designing, implementing, enhancing, maintaining and analyzing software systems. The prospective employee should be familiar with the following concepts/ technologies: ASP.NET, ADO.NET, VB.NET, VB.NET, C#.NET, XSLT, Java Webservices, Java Web-based application development, XML, Cold Fusion, Microsoft IIS 6.0, SQL Server 2000, 2005, Oracle, relational database management systems, and SQL. The candidate will also be responsible for reviewing and developing detailed system specifications and modifying existing applications to accommodate changing business needs.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Required Vendor Certification: Microsoft Certified Applications Developer for .Net (MCAD) or Sun Certified Developer for Java 2 Platform.

In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of satisfactory, full-time (not classroom based) experience in computer applications development planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; **or**
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in "1" above; **or**
3. A masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience as described in "1" above.

NOTE: In addition to meeting the minimum qualification requirements, incumbents may be required to update existing and/or obtain additional professional industry-standard certification(s) for current and future technical environment(s) in which they may be assigned to work, as determined by the employing agency.

PREFERRED SKILLS:
