**DIVISION/PROGRAM DESCRIPTION:**

The Bureau of Food Safety and Community Sanitation, which also manages the Bureau of Childcare IT needs, seek a highly-motivated, experienced Database Administrator/Developer to maintain and develop innovative environmental inspection data systems. Systems include the Food Safety & Community Sanitation Tracking System (FACTS), an interagency data system consisting of a front end client, web services and a Oracle database; and, Child Care Application Tracking System (CCATS) for Bureau of Child Care. The prospective employee should be at an intermediate or expert level in several of the following concepts/technologies: .NET (Visual Studio 2005: C# or VB.NET), Oracle and MS SQL Server, Web-based application development (ASP.NET), XML, XSLT, relational database management systems (RDBMS) and advanced SQL programming.

**JOB DESCRIPTION:**

With a broad scope for exercising independent initiative and judgment; the Certified IT Developer duties will include, but are not limited to:

- Design, implement, enhance, maintain, and analyze existing software systems.
- Developing browser-based, multi-tier applications and data transformation activities.
- Reviewing and develop detailed system specifications and modifying existing applications to accommodate changing business needs.
- Helping to develop applications and secure and ensure organization hardware resources are optimally used.
- Participating in planning of data architectures.
- Supporting developers in coding up scripts for our online product applications and operations management applications.
- Designing and implementing complex changes for integrations of databases to support information requirements.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

1. A Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by 24 semester credits in computer science or a related computer field and two years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience in computer systems development and analysis, applications programming, database administration, systems programming, data communications, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience as described in "1" above, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or
3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above. College education may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience in "2" above on the basis that 60 semester credits from an accredited college is equated to one year of experience. A master's degree in computer science or a related computer field may be substituted for one year of the required experience in "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and at least one year of satisfactory full-time experience in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project.
