Responsibilities will include: Implement and maintain enterprise directory services and identity management solutions; Create and support directory connectors to multi-vendor directories, databases and applications; Coordinate with agency contacts to implement and upgrade connectors; Work with Unix system administrators to implement/ upgrade hardware, operating systems and applications as well as resolve issues; Provide support in addressing issues where applications rely upon the enterprise directory services; Deploy new associated services/products related to enterprise directory and identity management services

*Due to the necessary technical support duties of this position, candidates may be required to work at alternate agency locations or work sites and work evenings; candidate will be required to be on call 24x7.

PREFERRED SKILLS

The preferred candidates will possess excellent technical knowledge of Novell eDirectory, including working with large databases, reading traces, and partitioning, LDAP design and engineering, solid knowledge of Active Directory. Novell Nsure Identity Manager 2.x experience a plus; Knowledge of Solaris a plus; Solid knowledge of TCP/IP required; An understanding of security issues associated with directory and identity management services is strongly preferred; Strong organizational, time management, oral and written communication skills are required.
