JOB DESCRIPTION

This is a highly technical position and the selected candidates will be responsible for applications development, including the planning, design, configuration, installation, testing, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance enhancement, security management, and support of complex computer applications programs. The selected candidates will perform these duties at varying levels of difficulty and with latitude for independent initiative and judgment. The selected candidates will develop, support applications utilizing Microsoft .NET technology including MOSS 2007, and create templates and web pages as required. They will create custom coding when requirement cannot be met with a standard template, as needed by the agency. These candidates will develop the following program components: web part, user control, and form which includes integration with back end databases and workflow. They will be responsible for the analysis of business requirements, processes, and data, provide MOSS technical expertise to help outline detailed technical design and requirements. The selected candidates will create technical and support documentation as required and support and respond to initial production issues as necessary (during the initial go-live transition to application support.)

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Required Vendor Certifications: Microsoft Certified Applications Developer for .Net (MCAD) and Microsoft Certified Solutions developer for .Net (MCSA)

A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in computer applications development planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; **or** 2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in "1" above; **or** 3. A masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience as described in "1" above.
