JOB DESCRIPTION

The Department of Correction seeks to hire a database administrator (DBA) with primary senior-level technical responsibility for managing DB2 Linux and RDB database environments and for designing databases for web-based applications for new and existing applications, responsible for planning, designing, configuring, installing, testing, troubleshooting, integrating, performance monitoring, maintaining, enhancing, security management, and support of complex data base systems. DBA works under managerial direction, with the broadest scope for the exercise of independent initiative and judgment. Routinely serves as in-house expert and authority regarding the above database administration work of extreme complexity and high specialization; and coordinates multiple projects of highly technical complexity. In the temporary absence of the supervisor, may perform the duties of that position. Requires certification and experience in DB2 v9 for Linux and appropriate certification in RDB and DEC environment.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Professional/vendor certification(s) database administration that is required for the position to be filled is IMB Certified Database Administrator – DB29DBA for Linux, Unix, and Windows v.9. In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in database administration planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; or
2. A four year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in "1" above; or
3. A masters degree in computer science as a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory (not classroom based) full-time information technology experience as described in "1" above.

Note

In addition to meeting the minimum qualification requirements: Incumbents may be required to update existing and/or obtain additional professional industry-standard certification(s) for current and future technical environment(s) in which they may be assigned to work, as determined by the employing agency.
