JOB DESCRIPTION:

Responsibilities will include: serve as a technical resource for the Senior Systems Engineering Team; primarily responsible for Windows 2003 Enterprise Server and NETAPP SAN environment for all OCME locations; oversee all aspects of system integration, server support, infrastructure, performance and maintenance; install, configure and manage redundant systems as well as documentation related to, but not limited to, all of the above. The Senior Systems Engineer will also be responsible for managing and maintaining the agency wide Audio/Video System which provides services to a 300 person Auditorium and several large and small conference rooms.

In addition, the Senior Systems Engineer will report directly to the Director of Management Information Systems and will be responsible for reporting technical issues to the Director; working on special technical issues assigned by the Director and participating in the process to resolve, and will supervise subordinate staff.

*Due to the necessary technical support duties of this position, candidate will be required to work at various agency locations throughout the City of New York and work various shifts such as weekends and/or evening shifts.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Required Vendor Certification: Microsoft Certified Systems Engineer (MCSE) Windows 2003, VMware Certified Professional (VCP).

In addition, all candidates must have the following:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and two years of satisfactory, full-time (not classroom based) experience in local area network planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; **or**
2. A four-year High School diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory experience full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in "1" above;
3. A masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory (not classroom based) full-time information technology experience as described in "1" above.

NOTE: In addition to meeting the minimum qualification requirements, incumbents may be required to update existing and/or obtain additional professional industry-standard certification(s) for current and future technical environment(s) in which they may be assigned to work as determined by the employing agency.
