Responsibilities will include: perform configurations, modifications and troubleshooting to firewalls, Intrusion detection systems, security management systems, security Network admission control systems; perform configurations and recommendations with network/ IOS security; define and troubleshoot site to site VPN connections; network packets tracing tools will be used to debug and analyze network traffic flow;
