

Maximo Developer Supervisor - Business Solution Technology

JOB DESCRIPTION:

The New York City Housing Authority is seeking a J2EE Developer to work as part of its post-production support team. The selected candidate will assist the technical lead in the day-to-day, hands-on support and enhancement of the agency's Maximo (Work Order Management) System. Responsibilities will include but are not limited to the following:

1. Assist the technical lead in directing a team of J2EE developers in the support and enhancement of the agency's Maximo (Work Order Management) System. This involves the integration components between applications, including components developed in custom Java applications and PL/SQL and develop plans for improving the stability and supportability of the existing package and custom applications.
2. Resolve application, interface, workflow, reporting and data integrity issues.
3. Play a key role in release migration, performance testing and tuning, upgrade and patch installation and testing; provide production support to analyze day-to-day issues and respond quickly to problems, minimizing the business impact.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by 24 semester credits in computer science or a related computer field and two years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience in computer systems development and analysis, applications programming, database administration, systems programming, data communication, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or
2. A four year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience as described in "1" above, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or
3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above. College education may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience in "2" above on the basis that 60 semester credits from an accredited college is equated to one year of experience. A masters degree in computer science or a related computer field may be substituted for one year of required experience in "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and at least one year of satisfactory full-time experience in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project.

QUALIFICATIONS DESIRED:

1. Five or more years of J2EE development experience.
2. Extensive knowledge of client side programming in JAVA, HTML, JavaScript and JAVA Applets.

3. Proven experience in developing and supporting software solutions in Oracle PL/SQL or a comparable relational database platform; configuration and support using WebSphere or WebLogic.

SKILLS PREFERRED:

1. Strong knowledge of JAVA development and JAVA class file structure.
2. Ability to produce technical designs and/or code for JAVA extensions.
3. Extensive knowledge of server side programming.
4. Strong knowledge of Maximo, including the Maximo Application Designer, Maximo schemas/tables/ relationships and Maximo Workflow Designer. E
5. Experience in writing Maximo custom classes (not just Java classes).
6. Experience in the support and creation of Maximo Actuate reports.
