# **Technical Development Manager - Business Solution Technology**

## **JOB DESCRIPTION:**

The New York City Housing Authority is seeking a hands-on Technical Development Manager to oversee a technical team responsible for designing, developing and testing Oracle Applications Extensions, Interfaces and Workflow construction activities in the Oracle ERP 11i. Responsibilities will include, but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Coordinate with functional team; manage timeline and tracking issues.
- 2. Participate in technical design, development, troubleshooting and enhancements of Oracle Applications, when required.
- 3. Anticipate and manage issues and risks.
- 4. Lead and mentor internal staff and vendor teams.
- 5. Interface with internal and external IT areas, Operations, and Product.
- 6. Coordinate integration with core systems.
- 7. Liaise with internal and external clients to direct design, business resolution and technical requirements.

### **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

- 1. A master's degree in computer science from an accredited college and three years of progressively more responsible, full-time, satisfactory experience using information technology in computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, data base administration, planning of data/information processing, user services, or area networks at least 18 months of this experience must have been in an administrative, managerial or executive capacity in the areas of computer applications programming, systems programming, computer systems development, data telecommunications, database administration, or planning of data processing or in the supervision of staff performing these duties; or
- 2. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college and four years of experience as described in"1" above; or
- 3. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a State's department of education or recognized accrediting organization and six years of experience as described in "1" above; or
- 4. Satisfactory combination of education and experience equivalent to "1", "2" or "3" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a State's department of education or recognized accrediting organization and must possess at least three years of experience as described in "1" above, including the 18 months of administrative, managerial, executive or supervisory experience as described in "1" above.

**Note:** The following types of experience are not acceptable: superficial use of preprogrammed software without complex programming, design, implementation or management of the product; use of word processing packages; use of a hand held calculator; primarily the entering or updating of data in a system; the operation of data processing hardware or consoles.

#### **EDUCATION & EXPERIENCE PREFERRED:**

- 1. BS degree in Engineering, Computer Science or related field.
- 2. Minimum 5 years managing technology projects.
- 3. Fundamental understanding of large scale financial and supply chain systems and technologies with corporate perspective.

Knowledge of SOA technologies such as Oracle BPEL, ESB and development of web services is preferred.
