JOB DESCRIPTION

Under general supervision, with wide latitude for the exercise of independent initiative and judgement, supervises a unit engaged in planning, designing, configuring, installing, testing, troubleshooting, integrating, performance monitoring, maintaining, enhancing, security management, and support of database systems, and performs related functions using Windows 2000/3, Linux, and other operating systems. Develops and maintains PC database applications to store and manage the data that is captured on the TLC's online forms, graphics and text. Candidate must be able to work closely with end-users, project managers, and other technical staff.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) Baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, and two years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) experience in database administration, planning, design, configuration, installation, troubleshooting, integration, performance monitoring, maintenance, enhancement, and security management; or
- 2) A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time (not classroom based) information technology experience of which at least 2 years must have been as described in 1" above; or
- 3) A masters degree in computer science or a related field from an accredited college may substitute for one year of experience. However, all candidates must have at least one year of satisfactory (not classroom based) full-time information technology experience as described in "1" above.

Note: In addition to meeting the minimum Qualification Requirements:

The candidate is expected to hold a current (within 2 years) professional certification as a Microsoft Certified Database Administrator (MCDBA) and has been working in its capacity for the last two years. Incumbents may also be required to update existing and/or obtain additional professional industry-standard certification(s) for current and future technical environment(s) in which they may be assigned to work, as determined by the employing agency.
