

**A RESOLUTION OF THE NEW YORK CITY
WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE
RATIFYING A CONTRACT FOR THE DELIVERY OF
EMPLOYMENT SERVICES IN HUNTS POINT**

WHEREAS, at its October 13, 2004 meeting, the Executive Committee of the New York City Workforce Investment Board (the “Executive Committee”) authorized the New York City Department of Small Business Services (“DSBS”) to enter into a contract with the Hunts Point Economic Development Corporation for the Hunts Point Works demonstration project to deliver employment services in the Hunts Point area of the Bronx (the “Demonstration Contract”);

WHEREAS, the Demonstration Contract terminated on June 30, 2007;

WHEREAS, the Mayor’s Hunts Point Vision Plan seeks to better connect jobseekers in Hunts Point with employment opportunities;

WHEREAS, Hunts Point suffers from an unemployment rate that is significantly higher than New York City’s overall unemployment rate;

WHEREAS, DSBS wishes to continue to provide the residents of Hunts Point with locally-based employment services (the “Services”);

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee, at its March 1, 2007 meeting, authorized DSBS to release a Request for Proposals for the delivery of the Services;

WHEREAS, DSBS, in accordance with the City’s Procurement Policy Board Rules, has selected VIP COMMUNITY SERVICES d/b/a MANAGED WORK SERVICES OF NEW YORK to provide the Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Committee as follows:

1. DSBS is authorized to enter into a three-year contract with VIP COMMUNITY SERVICES d/b/a MANAGED WORK SERVICES OF NEW YORK (the “Contractor”) as follows:
 - a. The contract will have a three-year term in the amount of \$2,500,000 with a three-year option to renew at DSBS’s discretion.
 - b. DSBS anticipates that the Contractor will register a minimum of 2,000 customers in orientation and place at least 685 customers in each year of the contract.
 - c. The Contractor will provide the Services consistent with the Workforce Investment Act and the Workforce1 Career Center contracts previously approved by the Executive Committee.
2. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.
