

**SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR A
LETTER OF COMMITMENT FROM THE
NYC WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD REGARDING
STATE ENERGY SECTOR PARTNERSHIP (SESP) AND TRAINING GRANTS
Funding Opportunity # SGA/DFA PY-08-20**

On June 24, 2009, the United State Department of Labor (“USDOL”) released a Solicitation for Grant Applications for State Workforce Boards to invest in workforce sector strategies that target energy efficiency (“EE”) and renewable energy (“RE”) industries and other green industries that align with the Governor’s overall workforce vision, State energy policies, and local and regional training activities that lead to employment in targeted industry sectors (referred to herein as the “State Energy Sector Partnership and Training SGA”) funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). (<http://www.doleta.gov/grants/pdf/SGA-DFA-PY-08-20.pdf>) **Eligible applicants must submit a completed proposal to USDOL no later than 4:00 PM Eastern Time on October 20, 2009.**

Applicant Eligibility:

- State Workforce Boards (with only one application per State)
