

**SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR A
LETTER OF COMMITMENT FROM THE
NYC WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD REGARDING
STATE LABOR MARKET INFORMATION IMPROVEMENT GRANTS
Funding Opportunity # SGA/DFA PY-08-17**

On June 24, 2009, the United State Department of Labor (“USDOL”) released a Solicitation for Grant Applications for State Workforce Boards to invest in workforce and labor market information and data as the foundation on which to build and implement effective workforce development strategies. This grant funds State Workforce Boards to collect, analyze, and disseminate labor market information, and to enhance the labor exchange infrastructure for careers within the energy efficiency (“EE”) and renewable energy (“RE”) industries (referred to herein as the “State Labor Market Information Improvement SGA”) funded through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). (<http://www.doleta.gov/grants/pdf/SGA-DFA-PY-08-17.pdf>) **Eligible applicants must submit a completed proposal to USDOL no later than 4:00 PM Eastern Time on August 14, 2009.**

Applicant Eligibility:

- State Workforce Boards (with only one application per State- states may partner as a consortium)

As the applicant for the State Labor Market Information Improvement SGA must be the State Workforce Board, the NYC WIB will not be issuing letters of support to organizations for this grant. Any inquiries into letters of support for this grant should be directed to the State Workforce Board.
