Program Title:

Intensive Preventive Services and Aftercare Services for Adolescents

Description/Purpose of Program:

To provide quality preventive services to avoid foster care placement of adolescents who are at home, and for those in care to expedite their return to a home-based setting.

Target Population:

Adolescents, referred prior to their 18th birthday, who are at risk of out-of-home placement, and/or Family Court proceedings because their behavior is viewed by their parents as “uncontrollable”.

Adolescents up to age 21 years at the time of referral, who are currently placed in a residential setting for whom a permanent family-based connection is sought.

Service Levels/Performance Requirements:

To provide or be able to access crisis intervention, family mediation, community-based wraparound and other services aimed at avoiding foster care placement and allowing young people in residential settings to “step down” into a family setting and to remain safely in that setting.
