### What do I need bring to the class?

You **must** bring the following with you to attend class:

- This letter.
- A \$20 money order – made payable to the school.
- Your TLC driver’s license.
- Your state Department of Motor Vehicle driver license. If your D.M.V. license does not bear your photograph, bring your temporary D.M.V. license and additional identification bearing a photograph of yourself with your signature (i.e., Passport).
- Your Social Security Card.

### What information does the four (4) hour Continuing Education Course provide to “Yellow” Taxicab drivers?

This program, developed by the Taxi & Limousine Commission, is designed to help maintain the level of professionalism and expertise that has come to be expected of New York City “yellow” taxicab drivers. The required program consists of a one-time, four (4)-hour course.

The course focuses on driver/passenger relations, with an emphasis on serving the needs of people with disabilities. The course will draw upon your experiences as a professional and the shared experiences of your colleagues and experts in the field. This is a wonderful opportunity, at the completion of your first year in the business, to build upon your customer service skills and utilize them to ensure your professional success.
