### TLC LICENSING AND ADJUDICATION FACILITIES TO CLOSE DUE TO POTENTIAL STRIKE

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces that its Licensing and Adjudication facilities, located at 32-02 Queens Boulevard, will close due to the possibility of an illegal transit strike, and will remain closed for a minimum of one day, and until further notice.

As originally announced in Emergency [Industry Notice #03](#), the TLC will also close its Woodside Safety and Emissions facility for regularly scheduled inspections (Hack Site will remain operational) until further notice.

The closure of these facilities is due to the redeployment of TLC personnel to key contingency plan-related functions. The TLC will communicate further status updates as they become available.
