Re: Inspection Stickers

Beginning January 1, 2007, medallion taxicabs are no longer required to get a NYS inspection at an outside facility in addition to the three annual inspections taking place at the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission's (TLC) Woodside, Queens Inspection facility. The TLC Safety and Emissions "PASS" sticker is to be honored by all law enforcement agencies and jurisdictions as being a valid NYS inspection sticker as per New York State Department of Motor Vehicles.

This will mean that only two stickers; the vehicle registration and the TLC inspection stickers will now be affixed to the windshield of a medallion taxicab that has passed its NYS/TLC inspection.

Vehicles that do not pass the TLC Inspection will only have the registration sticker on the windshield and will be subject to enforcement actions.
