At the fair, trained enrollers will be available to register your uninsured child(ren) for free or low cost health insurance.

Please bring one of the following documents in each category:

Child's Identity: Passport, Birth Certificate, Official Photo ID, Official School Records, or Baptismal Certificate

Residency: ID Card with Picture, Driver's License, Post Card, Dated Utility Bill, Postmarked Envelope, or Magazine Label

Income: Four (4) Consecutive Pay Stubs, Letter from Employer, Award Letter, Income Tax Return, or Unemployment Letter
