### TLC ANNOUNCES SCHEDULE FOR ITS FACILITIES IN EFFECT ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2002

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces that its Staten Island facility at 1893 Richmond Terrace, Staten Island, New York 10314, will be closed on September 11, 2002. The facility will be open on all other regularly scheduled days of operation.

All hearings scheduled for September 11, 2002 – whether at the TLC’s Long Island City Adjudication facility (32-02 Queens Boulevard) or at the 40 Rector Street Consumer Relations tribunal – have been adjourned.

The TLC Hack Site at the Woodside Safety and Emissions facility (24-55 Brooklyn-Queens Expressway West Service Road) will remain open for normal business on September 11, 2002. However no tri-annual vehicle inspections will be performed on that date.

The TLC’s Long Island City Licensing facility will remain open for normal business transactions on September 11, 2002.
