### TLC to PARTICIPATE IN NYC & COMPANY'S "TAXI APPRECIATION DAY"

NYC & Company, New York City's travel and tourism authority, will host a Taxi Appreciation Day event during the morning and afternoon of Wednesday, May 14. The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) will participate in the event in support of NYC & Co.'s appreciation and understanding of the important role played by New York City's more than 40,000 licensed medallion taxicab drivers.
