TLC ANNOUNCES IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING BASE LICENSING

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission ("TLC") announces the following information regarding the base licensing process.

Effective immediately, all new and renewal base license applications will be reviewed by the TLC Licensing Division, which will make recommendations for or against licensure to the TLC Board of Commissioners ("Board"). The TLC Board will consider each application at an open meeting, and vote upon the approval or disapproval of the application. The TLC Board will also vote upon applications for changes of location or changes of ownership by current bases.

In addition, the TLC will require base license applicants to complete a revised license application that will become available in late January 2005. Any base that files a new or renewal application after this time, or whose application the TLC is currently processing, will be required to complete the revised TLC base license application. However, any base applicant which received notice that its application had been withdrawn from the New York City Council will not be required to complete the revised application or submit additional information unless the TLC specifically requests it to do so.

Unless on TLC suspension, all bases with pending renewal applications are permitted to continue to operate while the TLC reviews their applications.
