### TLC DISCONTINUES POST CARD REMINDERS FOR MEDALLION TAXICAB VEHICLE INSPECTION

#### Other Reminders Will Be Continued

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) today announced that, effective immediately, it will no longer send post cards to remind medallion owners/operators of their next scheduled vehicle inspection.

The two other forms of vehicle inspection reminders will be continued. The inspection report that is issued to medallion owners/operators at the time of each inspection contains the date and time of the next scheduled vehicle inspection. The date and time of the next scheduled vehicle inspection is also handwritten on each medallion taxicab's rate card.
