**Attention: Taxi Technology Customers (ONLY)
EXTENSION TO INSTALL TAXICAB
TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS IN MEDALLION TAXICABS**

If you are a customer of Taxi Technology (TTC) and signed a contract with them, you have received an extension to install the taxicab technology (T-PEP) system. You have until the beginning of the next four-month inspection cycle to install T-PEP. This cycle starts on March 1, 2008. You must have the new equipment installed by the date of your next regularly scheduled inspection between March 1 and June 30, 2008.

Taxicab Technology Corporation (TTC) has provided notice to the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) that on November 13, 2007, it filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court, Southern District of New York, Case Number 07-13562 (BRL).

You will not receive a summons for failing to install T-PEP in your taxicab at inspection dates or at hack-up before March 1, 2008.

You are still required to have your vehicle inspected on your regularly scheduled inspection date.
