TAXI, FOR-HIRE ZONE FARES AND STREET HAILS DISCONTINUED DUE TO SUBSTANTIAL RESTORATION OF MTA SERVICE

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces that, due to the substantial restoration of citywide MTA bus and subway service, the Zone Fare System implemented to assist people during the storm emergency is discontinued as of 5 a.m. on Monday, August 29, 2011. This notice rescinds Industry Notice #11-19.

In addition to the discontinuation of the Zone fare System, street hails and group rides for all non-medallion taxicab rides are no longer authorized. All medallion taxicab service must be provided via the normal metered fare system, as provided for in the TLC's rules and regulations. All livery, black car, limousine and commuter van service must be provided via pre-arrangement as provided for in the TLC's rules and regulations.

To reiterate, the Zone Fare System and accompanying authorization for street hails and group riding for non-medallion vehicles, as provided for in Industry Notice #11-19, is hereby discontinued as of 5 a.m. on Monday, August 29, 2011.
