### ----- TLC-Licensed Medallion Taxicab Drivers May Participate in Pilot Program

Today, the temporary restraining order suspending the Taxi and Limousine Commission's (TLC) e-hail pilot program was lifted. As a result, the pilot program, which was temporarily suspended on May 1, resumes today – allowing drivers to accept passengers using an approved app.

Also today, TLC approved the **Taxi Magic** app (by RideCharge, Inc.) as the third participant in the e-hail pilot program.

Taxi Magic joins Uber and Hailo as TLC-authorized e-hail apps.

The TLC would also like to remind all industry participants that only licensed medallion taxi drivers in licensed medallion taxicabs may use this app (or any subsequently-named e-hail apps) in compliance with the e-hail pilot resolution, which can be found on the TLC website at
