**PROVISIONS OF TAXICAB DRIVER WORK ACTION CONTINGENCY  
PLAN RELATING TO TLC-LICENSED VEHICLES AND DRIVERS**

Due to the possibility of a taxicab driver work action, the New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) announces the following contingency plan. Pursuant to Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg's Emergency Order number 104, the TLC Chairman has authorized the following changes to TLC rules or until further notice.

1. For the duration of the emergency, all TLC regulated medallion taxicabs are required to pick up additional hailing passengers while transporting passengers. The fares charged for such group rides are as follows:

Zone D	Manhattan: North of 96 <sup>th</sup> Street
Zone E	Brooklyn
Zone F	The Bronx
Zone G	Queens
Zone H	Staten Island

**TAXICABS - TRAVEL WITHIN THE CITY**

<b>CHARGE (PER PERSON)</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
UP TO \$10 (PER PERSON)	Initial charge including travel WITHIN one fare zone
\$5 (PER PERSON)	Charge for entering another fare zone

**TRAVEL TO/FROM NYC AIRPORTS BY TAXICABS**

<b>CHARGE (PER PERSON)</b>	<b>DESCRIPTION</b>
\$30 (PER PERSON)	Trips To/From Manhattan and JFK Airport

\$20 (PER PERSON)	Trips To/From Manhattan and LaGuardia Airport
ZONE CHARGES	Trips To/From JFK or LaGuardia Airports from boroughs other than Manhattan

- Children under 12 accompanied by an adult are free
  - Tolls are included in the fares
  - Riders from LaGuardia Airport or John F. Kennedy International Airport heading to destinations in Manhattan may choose to ride on the meter or pay the normal \$45 flat fare plus tolls, as applicable, rather than opt for the group ride/flat fare.
2. **Overcharges are not permitted.** Any driver charging or attempting to charge fares in excess of the fares authorized by the TLC will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law. Passengers should report any overcharges to 3-1-1 or via the TLC's website ([www.nyc.gov/taxi](http://www.nyc.gov/taxi)).
  3. Sample Trips
    1. Bay Ridge to Midtown Manhattan:
      - Up To \$10 for initial pickup
      - \$5 to enter Zone A
      - \$5 to enter Zone B
      - MAXIMUM FARE of \$20 per person
    2. Jackson Heights, Queens to Long Island City, Queens
      - MAXIMUM FARE of \$10 per person
    3. Washington Heights to JFK Airport
      - \$30 per person
