JOB DESCRIPTION

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) is the agency responsible for licensing and regulating New York City's yellow taxicabs, for-hire vehicles (community-based liveries and black cars), commuter vans, paratransit vehicles, and certain luxury limousines. The TLC licenses and regulates over 50,000 vehicles and approximately 100,000 drivers, performs safety and emissions inspections, and holds numerous hearings for violations of City and TLC rules and regulations, making it the most active taxi and limousine licensing regulatory agency in the United States. The USB/Prosecution Division of the Uniformed Services Bureau is responsible for the prosecution of all summonses issued by the TLC. Under the leadership of the Assistant Commissioner for USB/Prosecution, and the direct supervision of the managing attorney, the Prosecuting Attorney, will serve in the Court Unit of the USB/Prosecution Division. The duties of the selected candidate include but may not be limited to the following: prosecute administrative and consumer initiated summonses before the OATH Taxi and Limousine Tribunal; draft appeals of OATH Taxi and Limousine Tribunal decisions; draft challenges to the OATH appeals decisions to the Chair of the TLC; give legal counsel and provide training to USB personnel appearing in court.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduation from an accredited United States law school as defined in the Rules of the New York Court of Appeals (Sections 520.3 or 520.5) or admission to the New York State Bar.

Special Note: This class of positions has a maximum two year term.
