JOB DESCRIPTION

The New York City Taxi and Limousine Commission is responsible for regulating all Medallion and "For Hire Vehicles" within the City of New York. To assist in operations the Taxi and Limousine Commission (TLC) runs a number of, SQL Server, .Net and mainframe systems (in a Windows environment) to both conduct and monitor operations.

In addition to its other systems, the TLC recently implemented an Electronic Summoning System that uses .Net to provide a user interface for the manipulation of SharePoint data objects for the system's calendaring and document generation functions.

In light of the above the TLC is presently seeking an experienced .Net developer with a strong SharePoint background who is capable of working either on their own or as part of a team to maintain and enhance this program.

More specifically the selected candidate shall be required to:

- Perform all phases of a Systems Development Life Cycle (SDLC) as they pertain to this system including:
 - Requirements gathering
 - Systems Design
 - Systems Development
 - Testing
 - The promotion of newly developed code through a multi-tiered environment that ranges from development and testing to QA and Production

PREFERRED SKILLS

- Technically fluent in C#, ASP.net, XML, HTML, CSS and JavaScript.
- Development using Visual Studio 2010 and Team Foundation Server.
- Experience with SQL Server 2008.
- SharePoint 2010 development experience.
- Experience configuring and maintaining IIS servers.
- Excellent communication, writing, and documentation skills.
- Excellent consensus building skills.
- Strong analytical and problem solving skills.
- Ability to work as part of team and independently.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college, including or supplemented by 24 semester credits in computer science or a related computer field and two years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience in computer systems development and analysis, applications programming, database administration, systems programming, data communications, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or
2. A four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and six years of satisfactory full-time computer software experience as described in "1" above, including one year in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project; or
3. Education and/or experience equivalent to "1" or "2" above. College education may be substituted for up to two years of the required experience in "2" above on the basis that 60 semester credits from an accredited college is equated to one year of experience. A masters degree in computer science or a related computer field may be substituted for one year of the required experience in "1" or "2" above. However, all candidates must have at least a four-year high school diploma or its educational equivalent and at least one year of satisfactory full-time experience in a project leader capacity or as a major contributor on a complex project.
