

I need to replace the vehicle associated with my medallion. I have reviewed the list of authorized vehicles provided in the attached list and I am requesting a certification letter for the vehicle marked and initialed to be hacked up as a medallion taxicab. I affirm that I have selected a vehicle that meets the restrictions (accessibility or alternative fuel), of the medallion listed above. I affirm my understanding, by affixing my signature below, that the responsibility to ensure that the selected vehicle meets the requirements of the medallion under which it will be operated is solely and completely the responsibility of the owner and/or the designated agent requesting the replacement. I further affirm my understanding that the TLC can require me to remove the vehicle from service if a review of the vehicle at any time (before or after hack-up) indicates that the vehicle does not meet the requirements and restrictions of the medallion listed above nor meet the specifications in the TLC's Rules and Regulations. I also understand that I must have no outstanding judgments with the TLC, NYS DMV Traffic Violations Bureau (TVB), Parking Violations Bureau and DOF Red Light Bureau, and DOF Commercial Motor Vehicle Tax (CMVT) Division. If the TLC identifies any open judgments or obligations the Agency can hold back the issuance of any certification or hack-up letter requested. In addition, I further understand that I am required to report any new plate issued for a medallion vehicle to the NYC Department of Finance immediately after the plate is issued. Failure to do so may result in my being unable to conduct any transactions before the TLC.

I understand that I can only select a vehicle that appears on the attached list. The make, model and year of the vehicle listed on the following page must all match to the vehicle presented at hack-up. (IE: a 2012 Mercedes Benz ML350 cannot be selected and presented for hack-up due to the 2011 Mercedes Benz ML350 appearance on the list – a vehicle's suitability for use as a taxi can change from year to year as manufacturers make changes to the vehicles specifications that may exclude newer models from meeting our specifications.)
